Dog Park Information

The Paxton Dog Park is open daily from dawn to dusk and is located off of Summer St. between Fall and Stockholm. You may be asked to present your Dog Park ID (received at the time of registration) during your visit to the park. Failure to produce your Dog Park ID will result in expulsion from the park. Your membership is nontransferable and visiting dogs may enter the park only after their owners have filled out a one-day use pass. Daily admission forms are available on site.

Rules & Conditions

- ❖ The dog owner agrees to assume the full risk of any injuries, damages or loss connected with or associated with the use of the Paxton Dog Park. Owners are responsible for the actions of their dogs and may be subject to state laws and local ordinances concerning dangerous or vicious dogs.
- All dogs must be current with required vaccination and be registered with the county.
- ❖ Member dogs must wear both the Dog Park membership tag and county registration tag when in the park.
- Dogs must be leashed when entering and exiting the park. Member must have a leash at all times. Members must also carry a photo ID with them and present upon request.
- ❖ Dogs may not be left unattended or out of sight range or voice command. A member 16 years of age or older must be present at all times and is solely responsible for the actions for their dog(s).
- Children must be at least 6 years old and accompanied by a parent or guardian to enter the park
- ❖ Dogs that exhibit vicious, fierce, aggressive, or dangerous behavior are not permitted in the park. Excessive barking is strongly discouraged.
- Female dogs in heat are not permitted in the park.
- ❖ Dogs less than 4 months old are not permitted in the park.
- Members must immediately pick up after their dog(s).
- ❖ Food (people food or dog treats) is not allowed in the park.
- Smoking is not permitted inside the park.
- ❖ Members are limited to 3 dogs per visit.
- Dogs, owners, and users creating a disturbance or violating posted rules must leave the dog park if requested by law enforcement, Park District personnel, or designated agents.
- ❖ *Infractions of any of these rules can result in temporary or permanent loss of park privileges. Please consult the Dog Park Member's Manual or call the Park District at 217-379-4203 with any questions.*
